



You may want to accompany your child in the dental operatories during his or her dental treatment. If you choose to be in the room, may we suggest you follow our general guidelines to help us create a positive dental experience for your child.

These are important steps that you can do to actively help your child have a safe and successful visit at Kids Dental Specialty.

- Please permit our doctors and team to help your child understand what we are going to do using our “Tell, show and do” and voice control techniques.
- Be supportive of our practice’s terminology; i.e. “sleepy juice” instead of “shots,”
- It may not be necessary for you to tell your child in advance what we will do, especially if it will be different then what our doctors would say or do for your child.
- Allow our doctors and team to maintain direct communication with your child. Children will understandably listen to their parents more than us, so we want to make sure your child can hear and understand our instructions.
- Please be a silent observer and not talk when our doctor is communicating with your child. Support you child by always touching and holding his/her hands.
- Some children behave better when their parents are NOT in the room. If you agree to step outside of the room, please wait behind the glass door until our doctors ask you to come back inside the room. This technique may be repeated to help your child.
- If we are unable to do treatment for your child, there will be a zero charge for that 1<sup>st</sup> failed/unsuccessful visit, with \$50 nitrous oxide fee, if applicable. Each subsequent failed visit will be \$200, with \$50 nitrous oxide fee, if applicable.
- The insurance code for each failed dental visit will be D9920 “behavior management”
- All restorative appointment is scheduled for 1 hour or less because 1hr is the maximum time a child can tolerate in the dental chair. You have the option to schedule multiple dental visits, with or without nitrous oxide, or continue the remainder of the dental treatment under IV sedation w/our dental anesthesiologist. Please inquire with our team.
- Our dental team will not restraint your child. You will need to come with another family member to help hold your child in order for us to provide adequate and safe dental treatment for your child
- If at any time you are uncomfortable with our treatment approach, please let us know immediately and we will cease all treatment to discuss with you.

I understand the guidelines above and give consent for dental treatment on my child.
